WHAT IS MOBILE LIBRARY?

Reading is really common habit to children in a development country. Oppositely, children in Cambodia don't read much due to these reasons:

- 1- Unawareness of the benefit of reading books.
- 2- There's no library at school.
- 3- Few books in the library.

In order to overcome those problems, PKO has established a Brillion project. "Mobile None Formal Education Library" is a project which helps children as well as students to improve their reading skills. It encourages children to read books, help students to be aware of the benefit for reading various kinds of books... etc.



Plus it is not only a library but also a greatly place to play. Through the experiences in helping children that PKO has, it has learned

that **play** is the best method which efficiently attract as well as motivate children for any purpose. Subsequently, Mobile library is a place to read and play. The project is being implemented by using 4 motor TUK TUKs as the transportation of books, games and other educational



materials. Each motor TUK TUK covers 5 locations while we have 20 locations to be covered including both primary schools and communities.

TUK TUK 1



This motor TUK TUK is controlled by Mr. Kloeng Khemrith and another volunteer staff, Miss. Va Kanha. Mr. Kloeng Khemrith is not only a driver but also a responsible, educated librarian. Both of them are following a proper schedule which is set efficiently.

TUK TUK number 1 is currently working on Wat-tamin commune, which covers five different primary schools plus communities. Anyway this strong man is really struggle. Sometimes he drives under the rain and sometime under the burning sun light. **"I love working with children"** said Khemrith.

According to the schedule, Mr. Rith is responsible for Wattamim commune. Specifically, He has to go to Kampong Ampil Primary school every Monday, Anlong Lvea Primary school on Tuesday, Slor kram Primary school on Wednesday, Buo knar community on Thursday and

O'srolao Lek community on Friday. As soon as he get to the place, he arranged everything and have the teachers to inform the students. Usually, there are about 100 students join us everyday.
